Government Subsidised 15 Hour 3Yo program Rollout.

You all would have received an email from The Minister for Education – The Hon. James Merlino in regards to the 15 hours government subsidy for 3 yo program. In short, the Peninsula will be rolled out in 2022 with a 5hour program and we have until 2029 to establish a 15 hour program. This is very early days and a significant amount of thinking and planning will be taken to incorporate these exciting changes.
