Each month we will list a few of these words in our newsletter. This month, we have included the following:

Bubup – Children **Wurneet** – Creek, river

Biik - Land
Walert-gurn – Possum skin coat

April recipe – Ooblec

A quick, easy mixture that has a strange wet/dry sensation!

Pour some cornflour in a container, add some food colouring of your choice, slowly add water until the mixture is the consistency of paint. Your children will enjoy pulling and shaping this mixture! Have fun \bigcirc
