# Covid 19 Update:

The update for Early Childhood from the Department of Education and Training is the following: It is strongly recommended that children

- Who test positive for Covid-19 should stay home and isolate for 5 days
- Should not attend the service after 5 days if still symptomatic
- Who are symptomatic but have not tested positive should not attend the service

It is recommended that masks should be worn by a person who is a close contact of someone who has tested positive for covid-19 when leaving home, it is additionally recommended that masks should be worn by a person who has covid-19 for at least 7 days after a positive test when they need to leave home.
